Schedule: Sheep may begin arriving: Friday, September 6 – 8:00 a.m.
Sheep must be in place: Friday, September 6 – 4:00 p.m.
Show: Friday, September 6 – 5:00 p.m.
**Annual Dinner and Meeting is at 8:00 p.m. after the show. Contact Charlene Carlisle for more information.*
Sale: Saturday, September 7 – 6:30 p.m.

Show and Sale Order: White Romney rams then ewes followed by Natural Colored Romney rams then ewes.

Judge: Judy Moore, Eagle, Michigan

Auctioneer: Tyler Lobdell, Lena, Illinois

Entry Deadline: Monday, July 29, 2019

Entry Fee: \$30.00 per head. All entry fees are due at the time entries are made and are nonrefundable.

Commission: 10% of the gross price.

Sponsorship: The American Romney Breeders Association, as sponsor of the sale, will receive an additional 2% on the gross to be deducted from consignor settlements.

Classes: Separate Romney & Natural Colored Romney Classes

Yearling Rams & Ewes (born 9/1/17 – 8/31/18)

Fall Ram & Ewe Lambs (born 9/1/18 – 12/31/18)

Early Spring Ram & Ewe Lambs (born 1/19/19 – 2/15/19)

Late Spring Ram & Ewe Lambs (born 2/16/19 – after)

Special Sale Rules

Minimum Bid: There will be a minimum bid of \$300 on lambs and \$350 on all yearlings. Sheep failing to bring the minimum will be a "No Sale".

Registration Papers: All animals must have a valid signed registration paper turned in at sale check in. Registration papers are transferred and forwarded to buyers. Cost of transfers will be deducted from consignor settlements.

HEALTH PAPERS: You must have a currently valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) for every animal you sell. You will need two copies for each animal in your consignment (i.e. 5 sheep = 10 copies). Multiple animals may be listed on the same paper but you will need to bring enough photocopies. A Federal Scrapie ID Tag must be in each animal's ear. This applies to all animals in all classes. Please take the copy of this letter to your veterinarian if necessary.

The following information must be legibly written or typed on all Health Papers:

- 1) Owner or consignor name & address
- 2) Species & purpose of movement
- 3) Private flock tag number
- 4) Federal Scrapie ID number (must include premise ID and individual tag number)
NOTE: **Both** the private flock number **and** the scrapie tag number must be listed.
- 5) Age, sex, and breed of each animal
- 6) The following statement must be on the health paper and signed by the issuing veterinarian "Sheep in this shipment are not known to be under movement restrictions due to scrapie."
- 7) Signature and printed name, address, and phone number of accredited veterinarian.

As a consignor, please ensure the above information is complete and legible. It is your responsibility to provide the sale manager clear and legible copies. You will need two copies for each animal in your consignment.

ENTRY Forms: Please use the enclosed entry form or enter online at www.bannersheepmagazine.com. Stating generic information like "Information on Sale Day" sells few sheep, so please provide us with as much information as you have available. It is highly recommended that you include pedigree information on all entries. Sale Management reserves the right to edit or reduce the size of extremely long footnotes. Quality information for the catalog improves sale results.

Sale entries are accepted only by US Postal Service, Fax, or on our online sale form entries at bannersheepmagazine.com/saleentry. E-mail or telephone entries will not be accepted. Banner Sale Management takes no responsibility for entries not received. Banner Sale Management reserves the right to refuse any entries submitted. If you have any questions please contact one of our qualified sale management staff.

Catalog: A complete catalog will be printed in the **July/August** of THE BANNER SHEEP MAGAZINE, as well as be posted on the web at www.bannersheepmagazine.com. We also direct mail to a large list of potential buyers. If you know of anyone who would like to receive a catalog, please refer them to our website or provide us with their full name and address and one will be mailed to them.

Sale Headquarters / Hotel Block: A block of rooms has been reserved at the Holiday Inn Express, Fort Atkinson, WI, (920) 563-3600. Be sure to state you want a "**Sheep Sale**" room for the special discounted rate.

Penning Requests: Please include requests for penning arrangement with entries. We understand that consignors that truck or fit together wish to be penned together. We cannot guarantee these requests but they will be taken into consideration when penning assignments are made.



Internet Viewing of Events: LIVE web broadcasting of the Show & Sale will be provided. The video will be shared via Facebook Live on our Facebook page: Banner Sheep Magazine. While there will not be online bidding, potential buyers who are unable to make the sale are encouraged to have one of the Banner staff handle a mail bid via telephone while viewing the live auction. Phone numbers for Banner Sale Management personnel the day of the event will be provided in the sale catalog. Please keep in mind there might be a slight delay (around 30 seconds), and this delay can vary depending on network/internet traffic. Therefore, being on the phone with a staff member while your desired lot sells ensures the video lag does not negatively affect your bid.
