<u>Health Papers</u>: Consigner or Buyer will be responsible if health papers are needed. ARBA will have veterinarian available to contact. Sold animals and fleeces will be released on sale day by OSF.

- 4. Exhibitors: Anyone entering the sale must be a member of the American Romney Breeders Association as of August 5, 2022 and animals must be registered with ARBA.
- 5. Out-of-State entries will be accepted for animals and fleeces. If mailing a fleece, arrangements can be made with Sue Kalina, contact info above.
- 6. Minimum bids:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Terms: Cash, Check or PayPal accepted. All purchases are to be settled with the clerks immediately following the sale and before the sheep or fleeces are removed from the premises unless arrangements and approval have been made with the Sale Committee. The Sale Committee will close the bidding window and the last bid on each lot will be final. All animals and fleeces are at purchaser's risk as soon as sold. Registration papers will not be given to the new owner unless paid in cash, for all other methods of payments, registrations will be held until funds are cleared and ARBA will transfer registration papers unless specified otherwise by buyer. Sellers will be paid within 30 days of sale.

Online Bidding will be available with PayPal payment immediately after the sale. Pre-Registration can be done as well. More information to come on phone numbers and contacts.

SALE GUARANTEE

Except for those stated in the below guarantee, there are no warranties, either expressed or implied, as to the merchantability of fitness for a particular purpose with respect to the sheep being sold in this sale.

The warranties and guarantees set forth in the below guarantee are in lieu of all other warranties, either expressed or implied, and the remedies provided therein shall be the sole and exclusive remedy of

the buyer, or any party claiming through the buyer, for any breach of warranty or guarantee therein provide, and all obligation or liabilities.

- 1 Every ewe sold will be guaranteed as a breeder if properly handled. It shall be the responsibility of the buyer to return the non-breeder to the seller in acceptable breeding condition. The seller, after a fair trial, and the animal is found to be a non-breeder, shall have the privilege of replacing the ewe with one of equal value to the satisfaction of the seller, or refunding the purchase price. All ewe lambs are exempt from the breeding guarantee.
- 2 Notification of non-breeder ewes must be made to the seller prior to April 1st the following year.
- 3 This guarantee shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller only, and no other parties assume any liability, legal or otherwise, expressed or implied.

The Champion and Reserve Champion White Ram, White Ewe, NC Ram and NC Ewe fleeces will be sold in the live auction, sold by a live auctioneer. The other fleeces will be a silent auction at the wool department.

Fleeces sold may be released the same day after settling payment.

Fleeces not sold are the responsibility of the seller to pick up at end of show schedule or have made arrangements for return or mailed. Contact Sue Kalina if you need arrangements. If fleeces are not pick up by Monday, August 29, 2022 6:00 PM, the fleeces will be disposed of.
